Blistering dermatitis, in the area of trauma Infected fascia, permeates the left hand limb

Blistering dermatitis Presence of sepsis generate

Perpetual vomit of infection and vascular occlusion Widespread congestion, progression of rapid sepsis

Perpetual vomit Toxins secreted in tissue

Flesh start to rot Necrotizing fasciitis Exotoxic septicity Exotoxic shock

Necessary debridement, the dermis was deposed Subcutaneous injection, into the dorsum

Cultures were crucial To determine the bacterial agents involved

Flesh gone to rot Necrotizing fasciitis Exotoxic septicity Exotoxic shock

Inflammatory response Flesh gone to rot Followed By death
