White sand made up of shells upon which rests carious rock Then prismatic feldspar between these and former ones Hard white rock with yellow spots A heap of white balls beneath white sand

Same process now going on shore, living iron found in it Sand white from decomposition of feldspar in places Every rock is covered with pistiform concretions in places Impossible to tell whether it is Breccia of modern or older day s

Lower beds of white sand become filled with large boulders of l ower rocks Beneath this comes a line of another stratum More soily and contains large and more numerous shells A regular bed of oysters remains attached to the rocks
