The phenomenon of moon in the water is likened to human experie nce.

The water is the subject, and the moon the object.

When there is no water, there is no moon in the water.

And likewise when there is no moon.

But when the moon rises, the water does not wait to receive it's image,

and when even the tiniest drop of water is poured out, the moon does not wait to cast its reflection.

Does not wait to cast it's reflection [14x]

For the moon does not intend to cast its reflection, and the water does not receive its image on purpose. The event is caused as much by the water as by the moon, and as the water manifests the brightness of the moon, the moon manisfests the clarity of the water
